

We have hit our first target



but we still have a way to go

Dear EU citizen,

We want to say a huge thank you to everyone who has donated to our CrowdJustice campaign.

We are delighted to announce that we have hit our first target of £5,000. This means that we can now prepare to take legal action against the Home Office. If we had not hit this target then all the funds raised so far would have been returned to donors, and we would have been unable to proceed, so we are genuinely grateful for everyone who helped us hit it.

We still have further to go though. As a not-for-profit organisation we are unable to cover the full legal action from our limited finances.

This first step allows us to start the proceedings. To continue them though we need to raise at least £30,000. This is where we need your assistance.

Our lawyers at Wilson Solicitors have already sent the Home Office an official warning letter last week, this is, the required first step before going to court, last week, and we are awaiting its response.

The letter challenges the Home Office's "granted in error" policy. This is the policy that lets pre-settled status quietly expire, or strips family reunion rights from people with settled status. We believe this policy is unlawful, and we've given the Home Office 14 days to fix it.

If they don't provide an adequate response, we are now preparing to take them to the High Court. The additional funding will be absolutely necessary to allow us to continue with the claim.
