#We are writing inform you that a decision has been taken not to cancel or curtail your pre-settled status. This means your pre-settled status remains valid.

We previously notified you that we were considering whether to curtail your pre-settled status granted under the EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS) (also known as limited leave to enter or remain) because based on the information and evidence currently available it appears that you have not maintained your continuous qualifying period in the UK.

We have considered the information and evidence available to us, and we are satisfied that you no longer meet the requirements of Appendix EU to the Immigration Rules.

However, we have decided that it is not proportionate to cancel or curtail your limited leave to remain. As a result, your pre-settled status remains valid.

#What this means for you

You continue to hold pre-settled status (limited leave to remain) under the EUSS and your existing entitlements are unaffected. You do not need to take any further action. We are no longer considering the removal of your status.

You must continue to meet the requirements of your pre-settled status. If you do not continue to meet the requirements, we may review your eligibility for pre-settled status again. You can apply for settled status as soon as you are eligible for it. Obtaining settled status remains the easiest way to prove your right to remain in the UK permanently.

To be eligible for settled status, you will need to demonstrate that you have been resident in the UK for at least 30 months in total within the most recent 60-month period. This can be any 30 months within that 60-month period.
